On April 8th at Camerota Truck Parts (565 Route 3-A, Bow) we will hold an Allison Transmission Hands-On Clinic. Guest speaker will be Bill Wright, Director of Service Operations (Camerota – Enfield CT, Westborough MA, and Bow, NH) and Dave Clark, Corporate Lead Tech (Camerota – Enfield CT).

Allison Transmissions subjects: Service Intervals (seasonal needs, hard duty, for long life), Service Procedures (flushing, advantages of synthetic fluid, filters, cooling needs), Service Parts (torque converters, valve bodies, PTO's - what to do and what not to do) and Generational shifts (the evolution of the automatic transmission).
